18 ECERS-R (page 32) Item #14 Safety practices, 1.1, 1.2, 3.1- Zip top bags are not considered hazards unless they fit around a child's head or if you see a child using them improperly (putting over mouth, chewing on them, etc.). If observed, this would also be considered a supervision issue and should be noted in item #30 General supervision of children (other than gross motor).

18 ECERS-R (page 56) Item #28 Promoting acceptance of diversity 7.1- This must be observed during the observation to receive credit.

18 ECERS-R (page 34) Item #15 Books and pictures, 7.1- Some books must be rotated or added at least monthly to receive credit.

18 ECERS-R (page 39) Item #19 Fine motor, 7.1- Some fine motor materials must be rotated or added at least monthly to receive credit.

18 ECERS-R (page 46) Item #23 Sand/water, 7.1- If the same provision is used indoors or outdoors for both sand and water (for example, a table in the classroom is used for sand and water play), staff must report the materials are changed every two weeks, alternating with sand and water.

18 ECERS-R (page 48) Item #24 Dramatic play, 7.1- Some dramatic play materials must be rotated or added at least monthly to receive credit.

18 ECERS-R (page 52) Item #26 Math/number 7.2- Some math/number materials must be rotated or added at least monthly to receive credit.
