(B) FCCERS-R (page 14) Item #1 Indoor space used for child care, 5.1- Consider if the physical space could support 36" between sleeping surfaces. If that is not possible, score 5.1 No.

(B) FCCERS-R (page 30) Item #12 Safety practices, 1.1, 1.2, 3.1, 5.1- Zip top bags are not considered hazards unless they fit around a child's head or if you see a child using them improperly (putting over mouth, chewing on them, etc.). If observed, this would also be considered a supervision issue and should be noted in item #27 Supervision of play and learning.

(B) FCCERS-R (page 46) Item #22 Nature/science, 3.3- Since this needs to occur daily, "weather permitting" is considered here. If no experiences are provided indoors and the program does not report going outside daily or when weather permits, then credit cannot be given.
